Beware of the false safe product claims from so many companies.

When you analyze the *INCI* of some of these products (*INCI* stands for International Nomenclature of Cosmetic Ingredients, a list of names for waxes, oils, pigments, chemicals, and other ingredients of soaps, cosmetics, and the like, based on scientific names and other Latin and English words that you will find in the

bottle of your shampoo – from Wikipedia), you find out that **they contain harmful ingredients**.

This is a very straightforward guide, and its only purpose is to:

- Teach you how to stay away from harmful shampoos (this includes staying away from the false organic shampoos which instead contain aggressive ingredients);
- Recommend only the very best of the very best shampoos worldwide;
- Help you effectively fight the third enemy of the health of your hair.

This is the ideal complement to the information you received in the third presentation video of our natural program to stop hair loss.

Important note: if you cannot buy one of the shampoos mentioned in this list, get a similar shampoo with the characteristics described in the video, free from harsh ingredients.



A good and safe organic shampoo should be free from the following ingredients:

- GM Free (Genetically Modified)
- Sulfate Free (SLS, SLES, ALES)

Sulfates are used in shampoos and body wash products to make them foam and dissolve oil, as I said in the video.

The most common sulfates are:

- Sodium Lauryl Sulfate (also called Sodium dodecyl sulfate, Sulfuric acid, monododecyl ester, sodium salt, Sodium salt sulfuric acid and Monododecyl ester sodium salt sulfuric acid)
- > Sodium Laureth Sulfate
- > Ammonium Lauryl Sulfate
- > Ammonium Laureth Sulfate

Many people with allergies to sulfates are not actually allergic to the sulfate itself.

The problem is that some sulfates excessively breakdown the skin's natural oils and this means the skin is more permeable to other ingredients in the product.

There are two reasons why some sulfates are avoided in organic products.

The first is irritancy and the second is possible contamination with 1,4 dioxane.

Paraben Free

Parabens are used in cosmetics and many shampoos to preserve them, as they help to stop the growth of fungi, moulds and bacteria.

When paraben based products come in contact with the skin, some of the them are absorbed into the blood stream, and can mimic the female hormone estrogen.

Excess estrogen is thought to stimulate cancer growth and when some researchers found parabens in breast cancer tumours they used this as evidence of a link between breast cancer and parabens.

In reality the results are not quite so conclusive and to date there is a big debate about how dangerous (if at all) these chemicals are.

Predictably the scientists sponsored by the big paraben-using cosmetic companies say there's no problem with parabens, whilst the scientists working for the organic beauty industry say there is...

What we suggest here, at Endhairloss.eu, is to avoid produtcs containing parabens, just to be sure!

Here's a list of the 5 most common parabens:

- ethylparaben
- propylparaben
- butylparaben
- > iso-butylparaben
- methylparaben
- No Propylene Glycol
- No Petrochemical Cleansers
- No Silicons
- No Nitrosamine Contamination

- No Ethoxylate Contamination
- No Phthalates

Phthalates are used in cosmetics and toiletries to control viscosity, emulsify & bind fragrances.

The health scare around phthalates concerns their ability to disrupt our hormones; technically they are known as endocrine disrupting chemicals.

Research has shown that mothers with high levels of phthalates in their blood are more likely to give birth to deformed children. Phthalates are also linked to cancer.

No DEA, TEA or MEA

Ethanolamines (DEA, TEA or MEA) are ammonia compounds used in cosmetics as emulsifiers or foaming agents.

You'll see these listed on the ingredient label as "MEA, DEA, & TEA," abbreviations for monoethanolamine, diethanolamine, and triethanolamine.

The most serious concern about these ingredients is that they may increase the risk for cancer, especially with repeated and prolonged use.

- No Animal Ingredients
- No Artificial Fragrance
- No Animal Testing

Important

Go through the INCI of whatever shampoo you are using at the moment, and make sure it is free from the ingredients described in the list above.


If you see any of these ingredients, throw the shampoo out of the window! (Kidding: it could pollute the environment, just use the trash bin).

You should know by now that the shampoo you are using should not contain SLS, SLES and parabens.

These are the most common and known highly irritating ingredients.

But not many know that there are now some substitutes of these ingredients used by the companies which define themselves as vegan and organic, which are nevertheless dangerous and irritating.

The shampoos included in our guide DO NOT CONTAIN ANY OF THE AGGRESSIVE AND HARMFUL INGREDIENTS mentioned in the list, and have been severely and strictly selected, based on their ingredients, the testimonials of real people who have used them, and their functionality and benefit.




